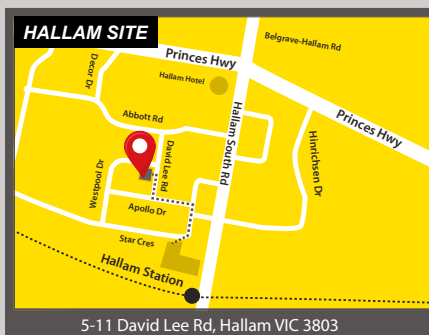
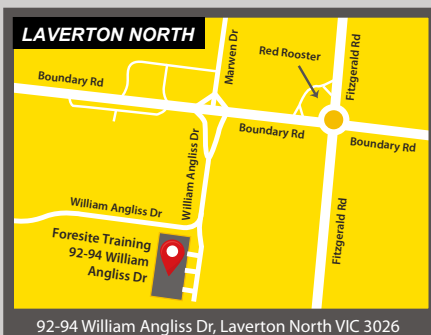

Entry Requirements

To be selected for entry into TLI30321 Certificate III in Supply Chain Operations, applicants are required to complete a suitability review, a task participation and medical checklist and a language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) evaluation, prior to enrolment. Additional entry requirements may apply depending on unit selection.

*Additional entry requirements apply. 1The candidate must be over 18 years of age and be able to present current government issued photo ID. 2Applicants must meet VicRoads eligibility criteria, including holding a current driver licence for a required period of time. (Speak to your RTO Representative for further details regarding VicRoads eligibility criteria.)



GET TO FORESITE TRAINING VIA BUS

FOR OUR LAVERTON NORTH SITE
Catch the 417 bus from Laverton Station. This service stops close to our facility.

FOR OUR HALLAM SITE
Catch either the 828 or 893 bus from Dandenong Station. These services stop close to our facility. From Hallam Station, exit the car park at the rear and head towards Star Crescent, then follow the road around to David Lee Road.
